Best wishes to Dan Little who is headed for some back surgery in the next week. If you need blinds hung you will have to wait until the "Blind Man" is back in business in the spring.

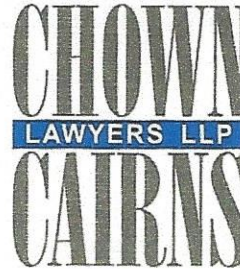
